Christmas is coming, and to quote Mariah Carey, all I want for Christmas is bûche de Noël. Here's our non-exhaustive selection of places to find one in Los Angeles.

Pitchoun Bakery

Since its opening, [Pitchoun Bakery](#) has impressed its clientele, and this holiday season won't be an exception. The Souliès family has dreamt up six new artisanal bûches: Aspen (chocolate with a coconut cookie), Kauai (chocolate ganache, mango jam, and a pistachio base), North Pole (a madeleine base covered in vanilla mousse and candied apples), Santa (raspberry madeleines, strawberry mousse, and crème brûlée on top), Mont Blanc (shortbread base, chestnut cream and meringue, all topped with whipped cream), and the Tradition (genoise base with vanilla, chocolate, or Grand Marnier buttercream). You can buy the bûche in a large size (serves 6-8, \$37), except the Tradition (\$32), which is also available in mini-format. Orders (sales@pitchounbakery.com) must be placed at least 48 hours in advance. — 545 South Olive St, Los Angeles; 8500 Beverly Blvd. #103
